## Jimbo Scott Band Comes to Town Feb. 10

The Jimbo Scott Band will perform at the CVIC Hall, 1602 Esmeralda in Minden, at 7 p.m. Friday, February 10, 2023.

Jimbo Scott has one of those voices that makes you stop, walk into the venue you were about to pass by, and see who is singing. A powerhouse singer-songwriter, his music recalls Tennessee country, bluegrass and Oakland soul. If you like Zach Brown, Tracy Chapman, the John Butler Trio or Jason Isbell, then you will like Jimbo Scott.

Scott describes his music as a poppy-folk rock sound, and says he writes songs based on “the things he sees.” One song on the album is about a road trip to Seattle and another describes a person he met.

A favorite of the Bay Area’s folk and Americana scene, Jimbo Scott has been entertaining audiences far and wide for more than a decade, including 2 years as a member of the famed NorCal Jamgrass band, Poor Man’s Whiskey. His solo work evokes traditions of Tennessee country and bluegrass, Oakland soul in sepia toned California landscapes and life-scapes.

## David Jacobs-Strain & Bob Beach Concert March 10

The Carson Valley Arts Council is pleased to present an evening with singer songwriter and prodigious slide guitarist David Jacobs-Strain who will be accompanied by his longtime musical partner Bob Beach. The duo will perform at the CVIC Hall, 1602 Esmeralda in Minden, at 7 p.m. Friday, March 10, 2023.

David Jacobs-Strain is a fierce slide guitar player, and a song poet from Oregon. He is known for both his virtuosity and spirit of emotional abandon. David displays a range that ties him to his own generation and to guitar-slinger troubadours like Robert Johnson and Jackson Browne. "I try to make art that you can dance to, but I love that darker place, where in my mind, Skip James, Nick Drake, and maybe Elliot Smith blur together." David also tours with Bob Beach on Harmonica. Their live show moves from humorous, subversive blues, to delicate balladry, and then swings back to swampy rock and roll.
