Pietro Accardi Art Exhibit In May-June

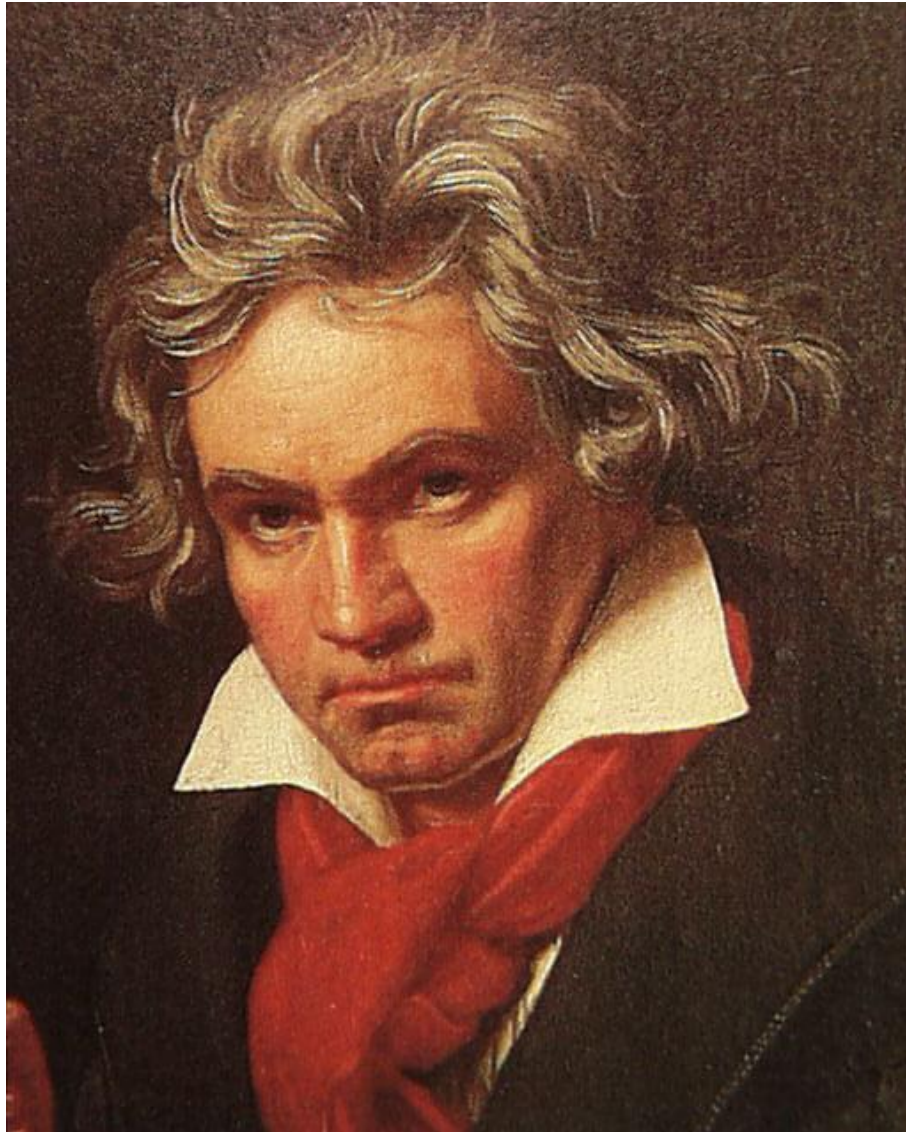
Carson Valley Arts Council (CVAC) presents artist Pietro Accardi at the Copeland Gallery in Minden from May 2 through June 30, 2023. Pietro's work includes Mixed Media (Water, Oil, Acrylic, Pastel, Mixed, and Photography). Pietro is a trained bookbinder and paper marbler and has transformed traditional marbling into frameable visual art as well as marbling on textiles to create silk scarves and other fine items.

Marbling is an ancient technique of making original prints from a water bath onto paper or fabric. It is known mostly in the bookbinding trade. Marbled paper is used as endpapers inside the covers of elegantly bound volumes.

The exhibit can be viewed Monday through Saturday 10 am to 5 pm. Pietro's work will be available for purchase.

CVAC will host an artist's reception for Pietro on Saturday, May 13 from 1 until 3 p.m. The reception is free and open to the public. Come and meet Pietro Accardi.
