

Mumblefinger brings High energy **Soul and Country with Rock Flair to our valley.**The Carson Valley Arts Council is pleased to present an evening with Mumblefinger, aka Brian Birkes The band will perform at the CVIC Hall, 1602 Esmeralda in Minden, at 7 p.m. Friday, October 6, 2023.

Brian was twice featured on the nationally syndicated House of Blues Radio Hour show and had a video (Exactly Like You) playing on CMT (Country Music Television).

Mumblefinger and his band have released many CDs independently and his songs have been showcased on the internationally syndicated House of Blues Radio Hour, NPR and radio stations throughout the U.S., Germany, and Brazil. His original songs vary from Funk to Jazz to Blues/Soul to Country to Reggae all with a swampy Rock-n-Roll flavor. Style is similar to, but not a clone of, Leon Russell, Joe Cocker, Dr. John, Robin Trower, the Subdudes, and JJ Cale, and Bob Seger

Plan an arts weekend getaway in the beautiful Carson Valley for Oct. 14 and 15, 2023.

Thirteen studios with 15 artists are featured on the free third annual Carson Valley Art Studio Tour. Meet the artists and learn about their creative process. All artists will have some of their work for sale. The Tour includes the studios of artists Teri Sweeney, western watercolor artist; Sheri Greves-Neilson, western oils, watercolors and drawings; Lee Lewis watercolor and silk; Pietro Accardi, marbled paper and fabric; Roger Kinnaman, pastels, oils and sculpture; Rielynn Lunde - Photography and Tintype; Terri Dickerson, silver jewelry; Tina Forkner, Watercolor; Bob Fairbanks, bronze sculptures; PK Klein, multiple media — watercolor, acrylic, monotype and copperplate prints, silver smithing, beaded jewelry; Michelle Mulligan, pottery; and Melanie Walters, watercolor. Two artists at the Douglas Co. Historical Museum are Ashlee Anderson, digital and cards and Constance Peters, photography and watercolor silk scarfs. Three artists at the Gardnerville Station are Irene Taylor, Watercolor, Batik and Ceramic Garden Art; Mark Harris, oil landscapes and Mark Thompkins, watercolor. Several studios have more than one artist, but all artists and their work are featured on the Tour website CVASTour.org.

The Tour website <u>CVASTour.org</u> includes an interactive online map and downloadable pdf file with the studios, galleries, information and art examples and background for each artist. The website also includes a schedule of special demonstrations and music features. Visit eight studios to become eligible to win free art. The Bow Ties are a group of voracious bluegrass pickers who have dedicated themselves to the precision playing of the masters' classics. With their passion for the genre, they bring the heartwarming sounds of traditional bluegrass to audiences far and wide. This phenomenal band is led by Northern California Bluegrass Association's five-time Guitarist of the Year, Yoseff Tucker. Alongside him, Billy Moore, a self-taught banjo picker, showcases both impressive accuracy and a deep understanding of improvisation.

Enter the enchanting world of bluegrass as classically trained Jack Kinney takes you on a fiddling journey that can either break your heart or leave you dancing on air - sometimes both!. The beating heart of this musical ensemble lies in the fierce rhythm provided by the duo of Zach Sharpe on upright bass and Michael Carroll on snare. Together, their seamless collaboration with the rest of the band creates a refreshing, exciting, and meticulous bluegrass experience that will stay with you long after the music stops.

John Warden at the Copeland Gallery – Sept. 6 through Oct. 23


Carson Valley Arts Council (CVAC) presents photographer John Warden at the Copeland Gallery in Minden from September 6 through October 23, 2023.
