Carson Valley Arts Council Completes Another Successful Year

CVAC again this year collaborated with TOCCATA-Tahoe Orchestra and Choir to bring three classical concerts to Gardnerville in 2018-2019.

Art Incubators housed at the CVAC building include the Carson Valley Community Theatre, Heartstrings, DCCA TV (Douglas Co. Community Access TV) plus space for Annex and artists. CVAC sponsors the Record Courier's Halloween Coloring Contest and Gingerbread House Decorating contest (now in its 14th year) for children.

CVAC Youth Outreach

New Ventures with CVAC Youth Outreach

CVAC provided \$2,430 in mini grant funding to Gardnerville Elementary School for a new mural, Scarselli Elementary Schools for the Missoula Children's Theatre and Douglas High School Music Department for new instruments.








CVAC Income & Expenses
