Challenges

The Carson Valley Arts Council had to postpone one of its 2022-2023 concerts due to inclement (snow) weather. The David Jacobs-Strain and Bob Beach concert was rescheduled to May10, 2024.

CVAC also postponed one Missoula Children's Theater production in a school due to COVID.



Partnerships

CVAC held its second annual Carson Valley Art Studio Tour. The Tour was highly successful with 15 studios and 30 artists plus an additional six galleries representing more than 100 local and regional artists.

In partnership with Main Street Gardnerville and local jazz enthusiasts, the second annual **Jazz and Art Festival** was held on May 21, 2023 at Heritage Park.
Five local bands performed on a Sunday afternoon to a large crowd. The event was free to the public.

After a ten year absence, the Carson Valley Arts Council presented the **Tahoe Adventure Film Festival (TAFF)** CVIC Hall in Minden on March 3, 2023. The Film Festival is a Fundraiser for the CVAC's Youth Arts Education Programs.

In partnership with Main Street Gardnerville and Douglas County Parks and Recreation, the first annual **Dia de Los Muertos Festival** was held November 4, 2022 at Heritage Park in Gardnerville.

In April 2023, the Copeland Gallery hosted the talented art students at Douglas High School. Kelly Yost's art class exhibited their art work in the Copeland Gallery.

Over the past six years, CVAC donated more than workshops, and assemblies in elementary schools. Over the past 4 years, the Arts Council has given \$11,000 in three-four mini-grants annually from \$200-\$1000 to teachers in Douglas County schools in support arts education




Total Net Assets - \$1,205,044
