Partnerships

Discussions and plans began for a new partnership with Douglas County and Carson Valley Arts Council to turn the CV Cinema into a performing arts center.

CVAC is working with a new local Arts Alliance bringing together artists, musicians, and diverse local arts organization.

CVAC held its fourth Annual **CV Art Studio Tour** in October, 2024. The highly successful Tour had ten studios and 19 artists plus four galleries representing more than 100 local and regional artists.





Carson Valley Arts Council provided kids art and partnered with Main Street Gardnerville and Douglas County Parks and Recreation for the highly successful third annual **Dia de Los Muertos Festival** held in November 2024 at Heritage Park in Gardnerville.





CVAC Youth Arts Outreach





Four of our six CVAC concert series performers; Dave Stamey, Red Dirt Ruckus, Misner & Smith, and the Paperboys presented assemblies at CC Meneley, Minden Elementary, Jacks Valley Elementary, and Carson Valley Middle Schools, to 1,742 students.



Missoula Children's Theater's week-long training and production of Pinocchio was presented at Gardnerville Elementary and Minden Elementary, March 2025. Missoula Children's Theater's production of The Wizard of Oz at Scarselli Elementary was May 2025.

In March 2025, the Copeland Gallery was host to a reception and month long exhibit of the talented art students at Douglas High School.

CVAC hosted Shaun Griffin, the Nevada Poet Laureate for high school students and the public.

Over the past three years, CVAC donated more than \$50,000 to support Missoula Children's Theatre, artist



July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025 Carson Valley Arts Council Income & Expenses


Total Net Assets - \$1,280,977
