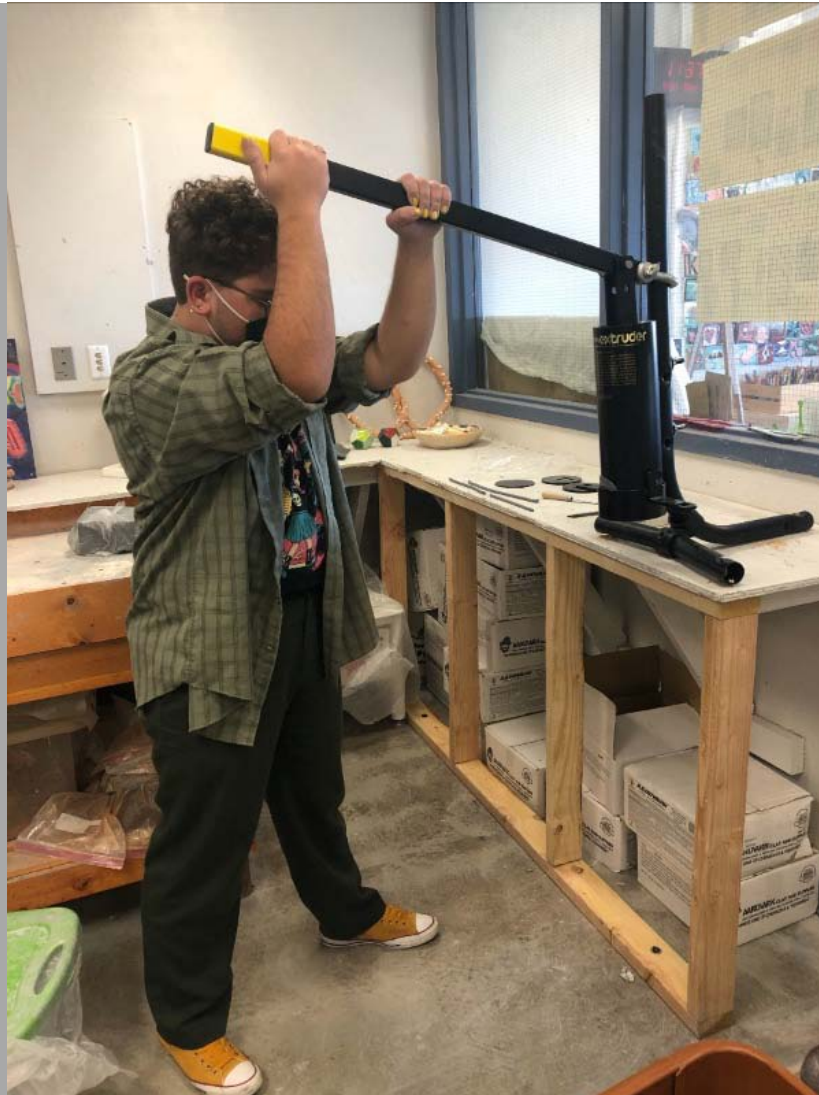
- They are looking for fine artists who would like to participate at this time, as well as local artists willing to share studio space.
