Carson Valley Arts Council (CVAC) presents local artists, the Carson Valley Woodturners at the Copeland Gallery in Minden from August 2, 2021 through August 30, 2021. The exhibit can be viewed Monday through Saturday 10 am to 5 pm. The Woodturners' pieces will be available for purchase.

CVAC will host an artists' reception for the Woodturners on Friday, August 6 from 5 until 7 p.m. The reception is free and open to the public. The Woodturners will have a demonstration during the reception.

The Carson Valley Woodturners' Club, a chartered member of the American Association of Woodturners, was conceived in 2006 by a small group of like minded individuals who had a passion for the craft of wood turning and an interest in showcasing their art.

The group is made up of novice to accomplished turners with everyone in between. They pride themselves in their outreach to anyone who may be interested in becoming a wood turner or those wishing to improve their skills.

The club meets at the Douglas County Community Center twice a month.

TOCCATA-Tahoe Symphony Orchestra and Chorus will continue their 2021 Tahoe Summer MusicFest with the Romantix: Beethoven Symphony #1 and Rachmaninoff Piano Concerto #2 with Guest Artist Pianist Nada on Tuesday, August 3 at 7 pm at Carson Valley United Methodist Church in Gardnerville (1375 Centerville Lane).

The concert will open with Rossini's Overture to his comic opera *The Barber of Seville*, and continues with Ludwig van Beethoven's *Symphony #1 in C major*, Opus 20. The concert concludes with Sergei Rachmaninoff's mighty *Piano Concerto #2 in C minor*, with guest artist Pianist Nada. Brian Fox serves as concertmaster, and Maestro James Rawie, TOCCATA's Founder and Executive Artistic Director, will conduct all performances.

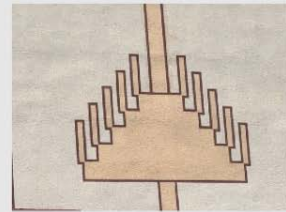
