## TOCCATA & MOZART - Feb. 18 at St. Gall's

TOCCATA – Tahoe Symphony Orchestra and Chorus continues its 13th annual WinterFest with Elizabeth Pitcairn In Concert, performing with the legendary Red Mendelssohn Stradivarius violin. The four concert series opens with Mozart's symphonic choral masterpiece *Mass in C minor*, featuring vocal soloists Joy Strotz, Anne Davidson and Becky Earl, sopranos; Liudmila Mullin and Jenna Sims, mezzo soprano; Brad Perry, tenor; and Stuart Duke, Emzy Burroughs and Chris Nelson, baritones.

Finalizing the concert will be Elizabeth Pitcairn, guest violinist, performing Mozart's *Violin Concerto #4 in D major, KV 218* and Saint Saens *Rondo Capriccioso* for violin and orchestra. Celebrated American violin virtuoso Elizabeth Pitcairn has earned a stunning reputation as one of America's most beloved soloists. Ms. Pitcairn made her New York debut at Lincoln Center's Alice Tully Hall in 2000 with the New York String Orchestra and appeared as soloist with the Philadelphia Orchestra at the Academy of Music. She has performed at Carnegie Hall and Walt Disney Concert Hall and in many countries around the world including China, Hong Kong, Hungary, Romania, Switzerland, Italy, France, Germany, Sweden, Finland, Bulgaria, Russia, Slovenia and the Netherlands. Jeff Lindhorst is Tahoe Symphony concertmaster. Maestro James Rawie will conduct all performances.

The performance is Sunday, February 18 at 4pm at St. Gall Catholic Church, 1343 Centerville Lane, Gardnerville in collaboration with Carson Valley Arts Council. Tickets are available at the CVAC office. General admission to all concerts is \$30 for all adults, \$25 for

## **Missoula Children's Theatre Comes to Carson Valley**

The Carson Valley Arts Council is proud to bring the Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT), the nation's largest touring children's theatre to Carson Valley with partial grant support from Tom's of Maine. MCT has been touring extensively for more than 40 years now from Montana to Japan, and will visit nearly 1,200 communities this year with up to 44 teams of Tour Actor/Directors. A tour team arrives in a given town with a set, lights, costumes, props and make-up, everything it takes to put on a play...except the cast. The team holds an open audition and casts 50-60 local students to perform in the production.



The show is rehearsed throughout the week and two public performances are presented on Friday/Saturday. It all happens in ONE week!! All MCT shows are original adaptations of classic children's stories and fairytales . . . a twist on the classic stories that you know and love. Also included in the residency are three enrichment workshops presented by the Tour Actor/Directors. Creativity, social skills, goal achievement, communication skills and self-esteem are all characteristics that are attained through the participation in this unique, educational project. **MCT's mission is the development of lifeskills in children through participation in the performing arts.**

**MCT will be at Minden Elementary Feb. 12-17 with *GULLIVER'S TRAVELS* and at Scarcelli Elementary March 26-31 with *ALICE IN WONDERLAND*.** The Carson Valley Arts Council is sponsoring MCT with grant support from Tom's of Maine and local Friends and Volunteers of CVAC.
