Tiller's Folly Comes to Minden April 8

The Carson Valley Arts Council presents Tiller's Folly, a Canadian folk band richly rooted in the Celtic tradition, at CVIC Hall in Minden on Friday, April 8, 2022.

Celebrating their 25th Anniversary west coast Celtic roots band Tiller's Folly share tales as old as time with a modernly lyrical twist. Inspired by true heroes and villains and backed by their patent mix of acoustic Celtic-influenced roots sound, they tell stirring stories of intrigue and adventure. The music of Tiller's Folly is uniquely representative of Canada's proud Scottish heritage. As one of the tightest, and unflinchingly focused folk bands in Canada, Tiller's Folly continues to produce music that is both distinctly Canadian and firmly rooted in the Celtic tradition.

Their lively songs of war, highwaymen and moonshiners, their ballads of love turned sour and the lonely immigrant's sorrow and the whimsical west coast sea shanties compel audiences to tap their feet, clap their hands and sing along with gusto.

Tiller's Folly is composed of Bruce Coughlan, songwriter and lead singer, Nolan Murray, and Laurence Knight.

The concert is at 7 p.m. on April 8 at the CVIC Hall in Minden. Tickets are \$22 and kids under 18 are free with paid adult. Tickets are available for purchase online at www.cvartscouncil.com, by phone at 775-782-8207, or at the Copeland Cultural Arts Center, 1572 US Hwy 395, Minden.

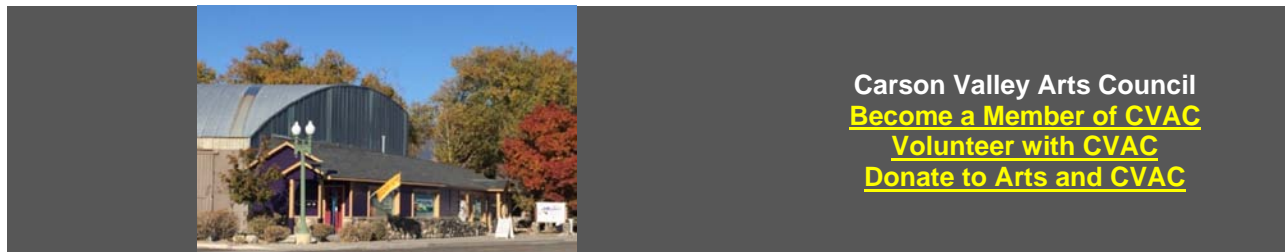
