New Partnership with CVAC and Douglas County

As of Wednesday, July 2 Douglas County officially owns the Minden theater.

On June 25 Douglas County commissioners approved a contract with the nonprofit Carson Valley Arts Council to operate the theaters for the next five years, with an additional three-year option.

President Brian Fitzgerald told county commissioners the arts council board approved the contract on June 16.

"We are very excited about this opportunity, and we really appreciate the county stepping up and purchasing the theater," he said on June 25.

Commissioners approved the \$2.9 million purchase of Carson Valley Cinemas on Feb. 20 after the property owner said the theater would likely close this year.

Fitzgerald said the transition in ownership won't have any immediate effect on the theater's operation. "It will be quite a seamless transition," he said. "You're going to see the same people operating the cinema complex. There will be eight screens still running new release movies."

For the first year, Fitzgerald said he didn't expect there would be a big change in the theater's operation until the arts council and the county have an opportunity to hire an architect and reaching out to the public to determine what residents would like to see.

"We're talking about ultimately a design with a stage that's probably four times larger than what we have at the CVIC Hall with fixed seats designed for music, dance and theater," he said. "Each one of those disciplines requires different amenities backstage, including dressing rooms, green rooms, lighting and sound. All that will ultimately be included in the final design."

The theater exceeds 20,000 square feet, but until the public process begins, Fitzgerald said they won't know how much of that will be devoted to the performance venue.

"We do hope and anticipate that there will be other forms of art that will be supported at this facility, whether it be gallery space, classroom space for the visual arts, and potentially offices for us and some of our partners," he said. "This certainly will meet the need for our local organizations that are looking for a place and we could work with the Douglas County School District to provide a venue for their music and performing programs, as well."

The theater was purchased using funds generated during the pandemic from transient occupancy taxes that are restricted to use for recreation and tourism.

LEAH ANDREWS FEATURED ARTIST AT THE COPELAND GALLERY

Carson Valley Arts Council (CVAC) presents local artist Leah Andrews at the Copeland Gallery in Minden from July 8 through August 29, 2025.

The majority of Leah's pieces are acrylic but she also works in oils or a combination.

Leah's paintings are akin to listening to a storyteller weave tales that transport listeners to distant lands. Each brushstroke serves as a narrative thread, inviting the viewer onto a journey. Much like a skilled storyteller captures attention with vivid descriptions, her paintings evoke scenes that beckon the mind to wander and explore. Viewers of her paintings find themselves drawn into the atmospheric landscapes and intimate scenes depicted on canvas, guided through a journey of emotions and memories.

"In my work, I strive to evoke not just visual beauty, but a sense of narrative depth. Each painting is a chapter waiting to be explored, inviting the viewer to become an active participant in the story. Whether

it's a serene countryside bathed in the glow of twilight or the magnificent power of a raging river, my aim is to capture moments that resonate with human experience."


Call to All Visual Artists In Carson Valley!!!
