## Jimbo Smith Band Comes to Town Feb. 10

The Jimbo Scott Band will perform at the CVIC Hall, 1602 Esmeralda in Minden, at 7 p.m. Friday, February 10, 2023.

Jimbo Scott has one of those voices that makes you stop, walk into the venue you were about to pass by, and see who is singing. A powerhouse singer-songwriter, his music recalls Tennessee country, bluegrass and Oakland soul. If you like Zach Brown, Tracy Chapman, the John Butler Trio or Jason Isbell, then you will like Jimbo Scott.

Scott describes his music as a poppy-folk rock sound, and says he writes songs based on “the things he sees.” One song on the album is about a road trip to Seattle and another describes a person he met.

A favorite of the Bay Area’s folk and Americana scene, Jimbo Scott has been entertaining audiences far and wide for more than a decade, including 2 years as a member of the famed NorCal Jamgrass band, Poor Man’s Whiskey. His solo work evokes traditions of Tennessee country and bluegrass, Oakland soul in sepia toned California landscapes and life-scapes.

Tickets are \$20 members, \$22 general audience, and kids under 18 are free with a paid adult ticket. Public art expresses local culture and heritage, beautifies communities, and enhances the local business environment. Our own Carson Valley Arts Council President, Brian Fitzgerald, is a champion for the working group on public art.

Douglas County is working with an arts & culture planning consultant, Debra Soule to assist in preparing the new Art in Public Places Program. The program will be based upon county-wide engagement with County and Town staff, with arts and culture organizations, businesses, and the community at large to inform the long-term vision, goals, and procedures for public art throughout Douglas County.

## Toccata Returns to Carson Valley

TOCCATA – Tahoe Symphony Orchestra and Chorus kicks off its 18th annual WinterFest with the “BRRRoque Masters” concert series January 7-15. The concert series is dedicated to the memory of Mark Lord, TOCCATA’s principal trumpet player 2007-2014.

The program opens with Mouret’s famous Suite de Sinfonie fanfare, which is better known as the “theme from Masterpiece Theater”, followed by Handel’s Organ Concerto Op. 4 #4 performed by David Brock, and Bach’s Brandenburg Concerto #2 with soloists William Cates, baroque trumpet: Heidi Modr, violin: Allison Smith, flute: Rebecca Mueller, Oboe. Other pieces on the program include concerti by Corelli and Vivaldi. The concert concludes with Scarlatti’s Cantata: Su le Sponde del Tebro, with Joy Strotz, soprano.

Concert performances will be conducted by Maestro James Rawie.

The Douglas County performance is Sunday, January 8, 2023 at 4:30 pm at Trinity Lutheran Church, 1480 Douglas Avenue, in Gardnerville.

General admission is \$30 for adults. Preferred seating is \$40 adults/\$15 youth and Premium seating is \$50 adults/\$20 youth. Youth under 23 years of age are admitted free, in non-reserved seating. Seniors enjoy a \$5 discount in all areas.
