Described as "the real deal," her tone is a blend of Brandi Carlile, Norah Jones, Joni Mitchell, with a magic all her own.

The second concert in CVAC's 2025-2026 Concert Series will feature music from Jessica Malone on Friday, November 14, 2025 at 7:00 pm at the CVIC Hall in Minden. Malone is the winner of several SAMMIES (Sacramento Music Awards) including Artist of the Year, Singer-Songwriter of the Year, and Folk/Bluegrass Artist of the Year.

For fans of soulful folk, explorative alternative, and those wishing to reach the true heart of rock and roll, Malone's music is highly recommended as an authentic avenue to a rendezvous with a kindred spirit. Her band consists of Daniel Roholt, guitar, Giorgi Khokhobashvili, violin, and Jim Frink, drums.



Tahoe Symphony Presents Messiah & Holiday Favorites December 13

The Tahoe Symphony will present their annual production of Handel's Messiah and holiday favorites on December 13 here in Gardnerville.

Joyous refrains and exultant arias, including the iconic "Hallelujah" Chorus, will fill the concert hall this holiday season. This Baroque masterwork, expressing the themes of hope, redemption and grace, showcases the magnificent artistry and skill of our celebrated orchestra and chorus, complemented by exceptional soloists. Join us for this wonderful holiday tradition!

Messiah was first performed in Dublin, Ireland on March 23, 1742 and was conducted by its composer. It continues to be a masterpiece that has left audiences in awe for 277 years. The Douglas County performance is Saturday, Dec. 13, 2025 at 36:30pm at Carson Valley United Methodist Church in Gardnerville, 1375 Centerville Lane.

To purchase tickets contact the Carson Valley Arts Council (CVAC) at 775-782-8207 or stop by the CVAC office at 1572 US Hwy 395, Minden, Monday to Friday 10 am to 1 pm. Tickets will also be available at the door 30 minutes prior to the concert and on the Tahoe Symphony website.

General admission is \$30 for adults and \$25 for seniors (65+). Young persons, under age 23 (with ID), enjoy FREE admission. Premium seating is \$50 adults, \$45 for seniors (65+) and Youth (Under 23 with ID) is \$25. Preferred seating is \$40 for adults, \$35 for seniors (65+), and Youth (Under 23 with ID) is \$15.

Save on Taxes and Support the ARTS


Several of our members and friends have used a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) payable to Carson Valley Arts Council as a way to reduce their tax bill.

Open to retirees age $70\frac{1}{2}$ or older, QCDs are a direct transfer from an individual retirement account to an eligible nonprofit organization. For 2025, the limit is \$108,000 per investor.

Once you're 73 or older, you can use QCDs to satisfy yearly RMDs and the transfer won't increase your adjusted gross income.

If you have to take a Required Minimum Deduction (RMD) from your traditional IRA,

a QCD can help you reduce your tax burden. Since it goes directly to a charity, a QCD is not taxed like your RMD is. Talk with your tax professional to see if a Qualified Charitable Deduction can help you and Carson Valley Arts Council.
