The second concert in CVAC's 2019-2020 Concert Series features music from Hot Buttered Rum on November 15, 2019 at the CVIC Hall in Minden.

Hot Buttered Rum (HBR), a souped-up, left-coast string band, is the brainchild of five uniquely gifted musicians who weave their love of bluegrass, folk, jazz and soul into a riveting strain of Americana. String bass and five-alarm fiddle merge with guitar, banjo, mandolin and drums to frame the voices of its two contrasting writers, fueling a dance party with roots in Appalachia and its branches in California. It's a sound that's as tough to describe as it is easy to love. Nearly twenty years into its journey, HBR's music, dreamed up in the backcountry of the High Sierra and the basements of San Francisco counties to play to audiences nationwide.

The band features Bryan Horne, double bass and vocals, Erik Yates, banjos, guitar, woodwinds, and vocals, James Stafford, drums and percussion, Zebulon Bowles, fiddle and vocals, and Nate Keefe, guitar and vocals.
