
**TOCCATA Returns to Carson Valley Sept. 2



CVAC will be hosting an artist's reception on Friday, September 7, 5 pm to 7 pm at the Copeland Gallery. Refreshments will be served and it is free to the public. Come and meet Camille and preview her amazing work.

Howard started loving painting in 1970 when her neighbor dragged her to a ceramic class at the park in San Fernando, Calif. Within three months, she was looking for more knowledge and found several traditional ceramic studios.

She took as many classes as they offered, and then from as many traveling teachers that her budget would allow. She was hooked.

Howard and her husband, Paul, moved to Gardnerville in January of 2002. "What a joy to find all these wonderful places to paint – the rivers, mountains, barns, eagles, hawks and all the wildlife, everything I could imagine," Howard said.

So she started taking pictures of everywhere they went. Howard estimates that she probably has 500 so far. Howard has also taught at local area schools.
